**A. All students will be gracious people of God who:**

1. Engage in prayer, study and worship at least 3 times a week.

**B. All students will be effective communicators who:**

**C. All students will be self-directed learners who:**

1. Set priorities in their schoolwork and extracurricular activities.
2. Make positive choices, assuming responsibility for results of their actions.
3. Monitor their grades to evaluate their progress.

**D. All students will be complex thinkers who:**

1. Compile information from print, electronic, and non-print resources for academic and real-world application.
2. Recognize and utilize higher-level thinking skills across the curriculum.
3. Understand and use problem-solving processes.

**E. All students will be collaborative workers who:**

1. Treat others courteously at school.
2. Understand the concepts of "respect" and "human rights."
3. Participate in monthly activities that improve school and the community.
4. Contribute positively during small-group collaboration.
