## SAT10 TESTING...

During the week of March 22nd thru the week of April 8th, children in grades kindergarten - 8th grade will be taking the Stanford Achievement Test. Prior to the testing date, please talk to your child(ren) about the importance of doing their best on the test. Discuss the significance of listening to all directions, reading each question carefully, and taking the necessary time needed to complete each portion of the test.

Please do not make any doctor or dentist appointments during this time.

If your child does miss a portion of the test, there are very limited opportunities to make up the tests. If your child misses a test, they may not receive SAT10 test scores for the 2021-2022 school year.

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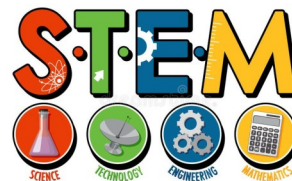
## Principal for a Day
